Employee and Volunteer Protocols During COVID-19 Phase 2
May 18, 2020

1. First and foremost, no employee or volunteer who is exhibiting any symptoms common to Covid-19 is to come to work or volunteer. Employees and volunteers will be screened for signs of illness upon arriving. (Symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit, or known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have Covid-19.)
2. Employees or volunteers who have been diagnosed with Covid-19 or exhibited similar symptoms must meet the following criteria before returning to work or volunteer.
 - A. No fever for at least 3 days, without the use of fever reducing medications.
 - B. Improved respiratory health.
 - C. At least 7 days since initial symptoms.
3. Employees and volunteers must wear masks while working or volunteering.
4. Limit the number of people working at the same time and maintain proper social distancing.
5. Familiarize yourself with the diocesan and parish guidelines regarding COVID-19 Phase 2.
6. Attend training to prepare for service during the phased reopening of our facilities.
