



What St. Philip's is Doing to Prepare for Your Return

- Worship services, Sunday school classes, and meetings will be available online during this phased re-opening.
- The sanctuary, offices, restrooms, and all surfaces will be regularly cleaned according to CDC guidelines prior to and after reopening.

Ways You Can Help Us As We Begin This New Normal

- Please stay home if you are ill, especially if you are exhibiting any of the symptoms known to be associated with Covid-19 or if you have had close contact with anyone who has tested positive for the Corona Virus.
- We strongly recommended that older adults and those who fall into at-risk populations participate in online services.
- Employees, volunteers, and attendees over the age of 10 are required to wear a mask while at work, attending services, or volunteering.
- Please arrive early enough to allow some extra time for the ushers to seat you.
- Please enter and leave the church through the Getty St. doors.
- Please refrain from physically sharing the peace, shaking hands, gathering, or lingering in groups outside the church before or after services.
- As you are able, please continue your financial support of the church during worship, or by mailing a check, or using the "Donate" buttons on our website and Facebook page.
- We appreciate your patience and support as we begin gathering and worshipping in a new way.



What You May Expect

- We will observe social distancing guidelines and wear masks. Please bring and wear a mask. Masks will be available at church if you forget to bring one.
- Ushers will assist with seating and dismissing the congregation. Please do not gather in groups before or after the service.
- Prayer Books and hymnals will not be used. We are not able at this time to have congregational singing. Music and the liturgy will be on television screens in the church.
- We will exchange the peace without physical contact.
- Communion will be distributed at the bottom of the steps in front of the altar. Only the bread will be distributed.
- The kitchen, Briscoe Hall, Grace Hall, classrooms, nursery, and playground will remain closed.
